Sunday School: A Place for the Whole Family

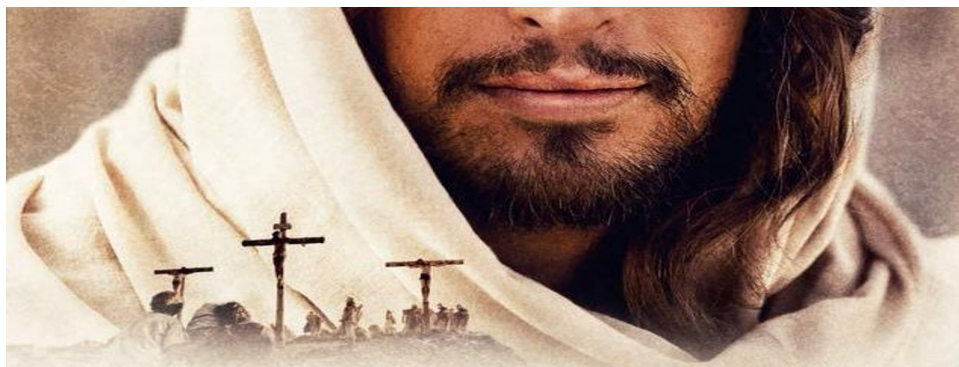
