NEHEMIAH: SUNDAY SERMON SERIES

Beginning Sunday, September 1: Introduction to Nehemiah

Throughout the ages God has used His people to have an impact in the nation. The book of Nehemiah shows us how God can use one individual in service for Him. Let's determine to be like Nehemiah when he said, *"I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down!"* In this series through the book of Nehemiah, we will see how God used Nehemiah to *rebuild* the walls that protected the city, *revitalize* the nation in times of opposition, and *refocus* the people on their God. Let these words transform us to be one who God can use to impact the nation for Him.

1. I encourage you to attend worship and participate in the Nehemiah Sermon Series by begin reading the Book of Nehemiah.
2. As we listen to Nehemiah's many prayers for success, forgiveness, revival, and restoration, begin praying these prayers in your life—for yourself and/or for those dear to you—God wants to rebuild broken lives, revive us spiritually, and restore our relationship with Him.
3. Read the entire book as we move through this series. Pay close attention to how God worked through an ordinary person, like you and me—to accomplish an EXTRAORDINARY work that impacted the lives of many people and eventually a nation! God has a purpose for your life and a great work for you!

NEHEMIAH: WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY SERIES

Beginning Wednesday, September 4: GROWING DEEPER IN GOD'S WORD

When God calls us to Himself, He does so for a very specific purpose. God will never do something great through us until He does something significant in us first. He wants to use someone whose heart is completely His.

Nehemiah was a normal, everyday, average guy who was living a posh life. But he develops a dislocated heart for God's people, has a radical faith and a courageous soul, lays out a strategic plan, exercises personal commitment and has a profound ability to adapt as both a practical and spiritual leader. His heart breaks for God's people and he does something about it.

Does God really have a purpose for you?

If you give yourself to Him, He will plant a seed inside you that will grow into a holy discontent – an issue in your life that wrecks you – and you just have to be a part of it. If you let God have your whole heart, He will mess with your life, and like Nehemiah, He will use you to impact the world in ways you could never even imagine.

1. I encourage you to make a commitment to attend Wednesday Night Bible Study. We will go deeper into the Book of Nehemiah on Wednesdays.
2. Continue to read the Book of Nehemiah. Get a study and prayer partner to walk with you through this study.
3. Allow God to rebuild, revive, and restore any thing in your life that Satan has taken or destroyed. We will learn how God did this in a truly broken and lost people that had been chosen by God but who had forgotten Him. God want to heal . . . He wants to save . . . He wants to REBUILD, REVIVE, AND RESTORE! **GOD IS ABLE!**

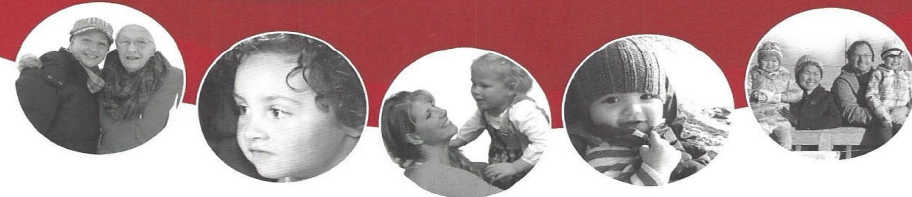

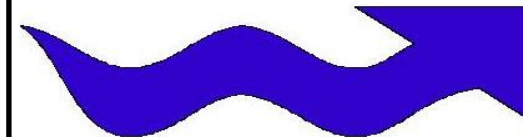
