According to Acts 2:42–47, I believe this is the best model for how the Church functions in a relation-ship with God and each other. But by the time we get to Acts 8, everything changes for the Church. The world is turned upside down in an instance. Stephen is put to death, and Christians are scattered everywhere in just a day. Those that gathered in those first days of the Church are now scattered all over the world. This sounds like what happened six months ago, March 22, with the coronavirus. We planned to gather on Sunday as usual, and with one stroke of the pen, everything changed. The Church did not look like it did a week earlier, and it still doesn't.

"Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went" (Acts 8:4). This is what the Bible focuses on, and this is what we focus on. Wherever they went, they continued to share the gospel with people. God did many miracles, and men and women far from Jesus were saved and baptized into the Church around the world.

Shiloh, we will be God's design for His Church: The Church Gathered and The Church Scattered. One has described these terms, respectively, as: "The Church Gathered is what we do on Sunday morning, the Church Scattered is who we are and what we do through the rest of the week."

On Sunday, the Church Gathered corporately in the name of Christ. We sing; we pray; we sit under the authority of God's word; we lament, and we give. Our awareness of membership, our perspective of the communal nature, and our conjoined submission to and instruction from Christ are heightened, calibrated, and enjoyed.

Throughout the week, the Church Scattered serves as bankers, lawyers, homemakers, construction workers, postal workers, caregivers, and a host of other things – all in the name of Christ as well. In varying ways, Disciples of Christ serve Christ and their neighbors through the use of their gifts, talents, and resources.

The Church gathered is a vital institution, and the Church scattered is an essential organism. The Church gathered is well structured, orderly, and Scripturally defined. The Church scattered is intuitive, sometimes seems chaotic, and Scripturally principled. Shiloh, whether gathered or scattered, let us focus on Acts 8:4 "Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went."

We will do this through Small Groups and Caring Communities: SHILOH@HOME! I encourage everyone to get involved in this NETWORK of SMALL GROUPS and CARING COMMUNITIES. These groups provide encouragement, accountability, and support we all need. We believe we learn and grow best in relationships through groups.

Jesus modeled for us the importance of a small group when He met with the twelve disciples. Shiloh, let us follow Christ's example. Look through this booklet and see where you can CONNECT and let us all continue to be the Church Gathered and the Church Scattered.




THE BOOK OF MARK THE SERVANT OF ALL, JESUS Mark 10:45

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Our Caring Community Groups will travel together with Pastor Parker in worship through the Book of Mark.

Pastor Parker says, "The Gospel of Mark is an exciting book about the life of Jesus, Mark's Gospel is always moving, proclaiming the theme message that Disciples of Christ are called to serve others rather than just be served. Mark's portrait of Jesus is one that displays His extreme power and authority from God, and yet Jesus uses His power and authority to serve others. Mark gives us the day-to-day example of Jesus, who endlessly gave Himself, not just in life but also unto death to provide for the greatest need of all humanity; salvation from sin. Again and again, this book forces readers to action as we examine Jesus and His purpose on earth, and causes us to re-evaluate our relationship with Jesus and the purpose for being His Disciple on earth".

The daily reading from the Book of Mark are on page 12. OUR DAILY READING JOURNEY WITH "THE SERVANT OF ALL, JESUS":

Before You Begin:

- (1) Find a quiet place where you can be alone. This will help you to focus as you read and experience God's presence. Be prepared to hear and listen to God. Psalm 119:18
- (2) Read the verses and record what stand out to you. Approach each reading with newness and eagerness to learn more about the character of Jesus.
- (3) Ponder your next steps. Let the word sink in. Let it marinate in your mind, heart, and soul. What is God telling you to do as a result of the reading? Whatever it is, be intentional about thinking, praying, and doing it throughout your day.
