

SHILOH 301 will help you to discover who God designed you to be. God has designed you for a purpose! When you discover that purpose, you receive the joy of partnering with the God of the universe! Every believer has a unique SHAPE. SHAPE stands for:

Spiritual Gifts: God-empowered abilities for serving him.
Heart or Passion: what you love to do and care about most.
Abilities: the natural talents you were born with.
Personality Style: your unique combination of personality traits.
Experience: the experiences in life that have molded you.

Why is discovering my SHAPE important in the Christian life?

Each of us has something unique to contribute in ministry. Knowing our **SHAPE** helps guide us to the right places to invest our time and service. As believers love and serve one another, our message to the world is strong and clear. You will discover your Spiritual Gifts which are special abilities given by God to be used to minister to others. They are a demonstration that God's Holy Spirit is working in us, enabling us to do things we could not otherwise do. Though the lists vary, each reference indicates that the New Testament writers considered Spiritual Gifts to be an important part of the Christian life. Biblical references are found in <u>I Corinthians 12</u>, <u>I Peter 4:9-11</u>, <u>Romans 12:1-8</u>, and <u>Ephesians 4:7-13</u>.

How do I know what my SHAPE is?

Taking **SHILOH 301** will give you an idea of what resonates most with you. You can ask your family and friends what they have seen you demonstrate. Find a ministry area that fits your **SHAPE** and see if you sense God at work. Through this process you will begin the journey of discovering who you are, why you are here, and what you do best! 


