





Pastor Undra Parker and Shiloh Missions & Evangelism Outreach Ministry urges Shiloh members to stand with Afghan refugees!

The marginal people of Jesus' day were his special concern. When we welcome the refugee—the stranger in our midst—we welcome Christ. Catholic Social Services of Anchorage is helping 100 Afghanistan refugees to resettle in Anchorage. They have ask churches and faith communities of Anchorage to partner with them in the resettlement. Pastor Parker has said YES!—for Shiloh and he is asking us to join him. We do stand with refugees and this is not our first time! We stood with the Sudanese refugees and the Katrina refugees and now we stand with the Afghan refugees!



The Book of Isaiah is sometimes called the "miniature Bible." Both include sixty-six sections: sixty-six chapters in Isaiah and sixty-six books in the Bible. Isaiah starts out narrating a holy God's need to judge sin. He echoes the Old Testament at the beginning of the Book and later prefaces the New Testament, revealing the salvation to come through God's Son. This study examines a broad narrative of Israel and investigates the very arch of God's Plan – to save His people by defeating sin and judgment through our Savior Jesus Christ.

All one needs is a Bible, a notepad, and a pen/pencil in studying this Book. Eight topics will be discussed with relevant insights that will help you connect God's Word to your life and live out God's Plan!
