

UPDATE: FEBRUARY 25, 2022

Dear Shiloh Members:

As we continue to follow the guidance from health officials concerning COVID, we are moving again to adjusting our mitigation plan here at Shiloh. <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/covid-by-county.html</u>.

Beginning this Sunday, February 27, 2022, <u>masks will be optional</u> while in the church building; this includes worship, bible study, meetings, etc.

We further encourage you to ensure the safety and health of everyone. Therefore, if you have been around someone who has been exposed to COVID, we kindly ask you to refrain from coming into the Shiloh building or any gatherings. If you are experiencing any cold, flu-like, or COVID symptoms, please stay home to avoid the risk of spread.

We have done well at mitigating risk and avoiding COVID transmission over the last 18 months, but we are not clear yet. Jesus calls us to love our neighbor, and right now, that means taking every precaution necessary to reduce the risk of spreading this highly contagious and harmful disease.

You can also check-in with one of the First Impression team members. You will need to use your camera or download a QR Code app to your phone/tablet to use the electronic sign-in.
