When we remove from this place, we engage as soon as possible to unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.

Reading the Bible in 120 Days

SHILOH ARE YOU READY TO GET IN SPIRITUAL SHAPE?

Shiloh are you ready to get in Spiritual Shape? During the months of May – Aug, Shiloh, we will read the whole Bible starting in the New Testament. Why the NT? Somewhere between Leviticus and Deuteronomy, of the Old Testament we tend to dropout. All the laws, genealogies, all the begot, etc.

When starting a dieting and exercise routine, it takes about 30 consistent days of 20 minutes of aerobic activity to see a difference. Reading the NT first will create that habit of reading approximately 20 -30 minutes a day. This will help to better prepare you for the OT.

So how will we do it, well as parishes, as team members, as ministries, but not as individuals.

This is an opportunity for Shiloh, for you, to not be a part of the 90% that has not read the whole Bible. Let's strive for 100% first through the NT and then finish strong. The spiritual disciplines of prayer and fasting are practices of many faith traditions. Prayer—intimate, authentic communication with the Divine—reveals our theological imagination, emotional vulnerability, and idealized values. Prayer is one of our love languages as the offspring of God and inheritors of daily eternity. Fasting can serve as a physical (fasting from food) reminder to pray and perhaps to pray more fervently. During times of crisis or decision-making, prayer and fasting offer the faithful an opportunity to meet with God. As evidenced in the Old and New Testaments of the Bible, prayer and fasting are powerful tools.

Our nation is in a time of great division and discord. Therefore, Pastor Parker and the Prayer Team are calling the people of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church to a 4-Day Prayer Conference called **IF MY PEOPLE** from 2 Chronicles 7:14, *"if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."*

Tuesday, May 3, 2022 -- Prayer & Fasting Training Zoom Only

Two opportunities to join the Training. At both times, there will be a message from Pastor Undra Parker and a teaching on Prayer and Fasting. After each session, attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions, share insights, provide feedback.

Wednesday, May 4, 2022 - Shiloh House of Prayer 6:30-8:00 pm (Sanctuary & Zoom)

The church will gather in the sanctuary and on zoom to focus on seven prayer points. spend time praying for seven focuses in the church. We will bombard heaven for those who are grieving, for our ministries, leaders, staff, and so much more.

Thursday, May 5, 2022 -- Family Prayer @Home

Families will spend time at home praying together as a family. The church will provide a Prayer Guide to be used at home using the Lord's Prayer as a guide. At 12:00 noon, Shiloh members will pause and pray wherever they are.

We will then gather at the church for a Shiloh Prayer Circle from 6:30-7:30 pm where we gather outside walking and praying around the church. Prayer stations will be set up with prayer focuses.

Friday, May 6, 2022 – Shiloh Friday Faith Fast

The church unifies in prayer and fasting from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm as we pray for ourselves, our homes, our church, our community, and our world. The Shiloh Prayer & Fasting Guide will be available to help guide you in your fasting option. There will be three times of prayer available on the Conference line at 6:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 6:00 pm

Together, we will learn how to reach heaven, hear from God, have our sins forgiven and our land healed. The three-fold goal of this Prayer & Fasting Conference is that members will understand the importance of prayer and fasting, be strengthened as they draw closer to God, and be a catalyst for us to become houses of prayer.

Parish Family Care Groups

In his role as Senior Pastor, Pastor Undra Parker, is called to shepherd (care for) the families of Shiloh. With over 500 families in Shiloh, it is difficult for the Pastor to account for, communicate with, and care for every family by himself. The **Parish Family Ministry** is the way the Senior Pastor accounts for, communicate with and care for every Shiloh family. He is connected and remains connected to each family of our church through the Parish Care Ministry. This connection is strengthen, nurtured, and maintained through the services of the Diaconate Ministry.

The **Shiloh Parish Family Ministry** is made up of fourteen "Parish Family Care Groups. Each Shiloh household is assigned to a Family Care Group. The assignment is determined alphabetically—by the first letter in members last name, example-- "Browns" would be in the "B" Family Care Group and Deacon Alan Growden is the Deacon or Family Care Minister for the Brown Family.

Shiloh's Parish Family Ministry is a **NETWORK** of ministries led by the Directors for Parish Family Ministry and is staffed by family care ministers who are ordained deacons and deaconesses [**The Diaconate**]. Your Family Care Minister should be the first individual you contact during a time of crises in your family, such as an illness or death or an emergency need for food, clothing, or shelter. They will pray with you, provide spiritual directions and walk with you to our **Family Support Ministry**. Family Support provides assistance with basic needs—food, clothing, shelter, and other needs for members experiencing crisis/emergencies in their lives. If your situation requires the attention of the Senior Pastor, your Care Minister will contact and inform him.

Family Care Ministers—Deacons and Deaconesses are trained lay volunteers, not professional counselors or therapists, pastors, or physicians.

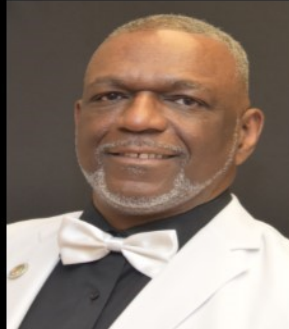
