

SERMON NOTES



ADVENT: THE SEASON OF PREPARATION AND EXPECTATION

Advent is the period of anticipation and celebration during the four Sundays and weeks before Christmas. The word Advent comes from the Latin term (**adventus**) meaning "coming" or "arrival." This is the coming or arrival of Jesus into the world. Christians use the four Sundays and weeks of Advent to prepare and remember the true meaning of Christmas. Christians proclaim three meanings of "coming" during Advent: Jesus' birth in Bethlehem, our acceptance of Him in our hearts, and His glorious return. Historically, Advent is marked by four observed themes each Sunday. There are numerous variations throughout Church History, but for Shiloh, we will follow the themes of hope, joy, love, and peace.

The Prayer Ministry has prepared an Advent Devotional Booklet, and we want each person/family to use it during this season as your time of prayerful anticipation. Today, is the second Sunday of Advent and we focus on JOY. Christ offers eternal hope and joy by Him coming into the world and bringing with Him salvation to a broken and lost world.
