MARCH MISSION MADNESS 2023

We will hear a lot about March Madness this month. Here at Shiloh, we want to reflect the passion of madness in missions. We want to be on the move all of the time, reaching out to those who are in need. This keeps us from becoming self-centered and it blesses us more than the people we help. Christ call us to be His hands and feet in our community. Our Foodbank provides food for about 25-30 families each week. This year, Food Bank of Alaska does not have the food and supplies to give to foodbanks as they have in recent years-which is a large supplier of food items to local Foodbanks, such as ours. There is a major shortage of eggs and purchasing limit of (2 per person at most stores), so we will collect them each week. During the month of March, we will be mission madness driven. We want to supply the following items each week:


