ALL: We further engage to watch over, to pray for, to exhort and stir up each other unto every good word and work; to guard each other's reputation, not needlessly exposing the infirmities of others, to participate in each joy, and with tender sympathy bear one another's burdens and sorrows; to cultivate Christian courtesy; to be slow to give or take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, being mindful of the rules of the Savior in the eighteenth chapter of Matthew, to secure it without delay; and through life, amid evil report, and good report, to seek to live to the glory of God, who hath called us out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Leader: When we remove from this place, we engage as soon as possible to unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.

The Shiloh Linda Colbert Memorial Scholarship recognizes outstanding spiritual growth and church service, outstanding academic achievement, leadership potential, service to community, and the desire to pursue higher education through its annual scholarship awards. Scholarships are awarded to church members who are graduating seniors and who will pursue post-secondary education at technical schools as well as four-year colleges and universities. Recipients are eligible to receive a one-time award of \$1700.

Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?

- 1. Individuals who have been active members of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church for one full year at the time of application.
- 2. Members who are current high school seniors, who have been accepted to a post-secondary Institution and who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- 3. Members who have been actively involved in Sunday School, Youth Ministry and other church ministries for at least one full year at the time of application.

Application Forms are available in the church office and by email. Applicants must submit all required documentation: application, letter of acceptance, and forms verifying participation in church ministries.

Applicants must place all application materials in a sealed envelope. All requested documents must be in the church office no later than 6:00 pm on April 30, 2023.

Why is discovering my SHAPE important in the Christian life?

Each of us has something unique to contribute in ministry. Knowing our SHAPE helps guide us to the right places to invest our time and service. As believers love and serve one another, our message to the world is strong and clear. You will discover your Spiritual Gifts which are special abilities given by God to be used to minister to others. They are a demonstration that God's Holy Spirit is working in us, enabling us to do things we could not otherwise do. Though the lists vary, each reference indicates that the New Testament writers considered Spiritual Gifts to be an important part of the Christian life. Biblical references are found in I Corinthians 12, I Peter 4:9-11, Romans 12:1-8, and Ephesians 4:7-13.

How do I know what my SHAPE is?

Taking SHILOH 301 will give you an idea of what resonates most with you. You can ask your family and friends what they have seen you demonstrate. Find a ministry area that fits your SHAPE and see if you sense God at work. Through this process you will begin the journey of discovering who you are, why you are here, and what you do best! The results of serving with your unique SHAPE are both external and internal. You will be more effective and fruitful in ministry as you use the tools God has given you and you will experience joy and fulfillment as you serve others.

How do I acquire a Spiritual Gift?
