





SEPTEMBER PREACHING SERIES

THE BIBLE

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

The Bible stands as the most widely sold book in history. Some people see it as a collection of obsolete and irrelevant tales, while others see it as encouraging and holy. Nevertheless, no one can deny The Bible's influence on human history. During this series, we will think deeply about the Bible, how it's designed to be used, and whether it's even worth believing. Join us as we encounter **The Bible.**

Week 1: The Bible?

Week 2: The Bible Is Special Week 3: The Bible Is Weird Week 4: The Bible Is Life

Week One, we will start by looking at what the Bible is. It's not a workbook with all the answers to our questions, a manual with all of life's rules, or a manuscript of inspirational quotes meant to make us feel happy when we're sad. The Bible is God's words to humanity that lead to Jesus, our Savior, and invite us to know and become like Jesus.

<u>Week Two</u>, we will look at the beautiful binding together of heaven and earth that makes the Bible so special.

<u>Week Three</u>, we will highlight common questions people have about the Bible—the weird, confusing, and challenging stuff.

<u>Week Four</u>, we will teach through Scriptures passages that show us how to apply the truths of The Bible to our everyday lives.

LEARNING TO PRAY

Prayer is simply talking with God. It is the way you share your heart with Him, and also how you prepare your heart to listen to Him.

Like with any other relationship, when you begin a relationship with God, you spend time with Him to get to know Him more. Prayer is simply a way for you to build into that relationship with Him.
