A Health Awareness Focus

Special Medical Speakers with Emphasis on African American Men Brothers, it's going to be a shaggy month. **No-Shave November** is a month-long campaign encouraging conversation and raising awareness of men's health. Men forgo shaving and grooming for the entire month to raise cancer awareness and evoke discussion about the amount of hair many cancer patients lose. Men are encouraged to donate the money typically spent on shaving and grooming to an organization. We want to compel men to get proper and timely health screenings. This year, we are raising funds for the American Cancer Society. Our goal is to raise \$ 5,000.

Support the Cause by embracing these commitments:

- 1. **Join the Community** God commands us to fellowship (Heb. 10:25). We do this together as one community. We'll be sharing our challenges and successes as men.
- Commit to Prayer. God commands us to pray for the sick (James 5:15). Spend time praying each day for your own spiritual and physical health and intercede for other men's spiritual and physical health.
- 3. **Stop Shaving** Christian traditions are filled with men who set themselves apart by not shaving (Samson, Judges 13:5; Paul, Acts 18:18). These were set apart as a vow to encourage and reach others.
- 4. **Share your Faith** God commands us to evangelize (Matthew 28:19-20). Share your faith journey with another man this month. It might be that you can compel them to accept Jesus by your testimony.

Baby Dedication & Blessing

November 26, 2023 | 11:00 AM Worship

For Baby Dedications: Baby dedications are for families who want to commit before God and the church that they will raise their child in a Biblical manner. By dedicating our children to the Lord, we are making a vow to raise them in God's ways and not our own. The following is a list (though not exhaustive) of some of the things we as parents should do as part of keeping our vow.

Pray constantly for your child. (Job 1:5); Instruct your child in the way of the Lord. (Deut. 6:7; Ephesians 6:4; Proverbs 22:6) Be a living example of Christ to your children. (Proverbs 20:7)

Discipline our children in the same way the Lord disciplines us. (Proverbs 13:24; 29:15; 29:17)

For Baby Blessings: Because we believe all children are a blessing from the Lord, we will bless each child regardless of whether the parent(s) are born again. We use Mark 10:11-13 as our guide; people brought children to Jesus and He blessed them. It is from this passage of Scripture that we bless all children, especially those of whom both parents are not born-again believers.

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14

We help our families year-round with basic needs. Families can be referred for adoption by any Shiloh member. All referrals are approved and processed by Shiloh's Membership Care Family Support Team.

HOW TO REFER A FAMILY:

You can refer a family for adoption to your Parish Leader[Deacon/Deaconesses]. Call your deacon or deaconess, and they will help you make your referral. You can refer your own family.

HOW TO ADOPT-A-FAMILY

You can participate as an individual sponsor or organize a group of friends or co-workers to work with you. Shiloh Ministries can also work together to adopt one or more families. If you are willing to ADOPT-A-FAMILY, our Family Support Ministry will match you with a family. You will connect with your family and discuss their needs for Christmas—then you give accordingly. Please share with Shiloh, not directly to the family. You will get to know the family and will be able to encourage and pray with and for them long after the Christmas season is over.


