Shiloh is a church with a mission and vision. To fulfill our purposes, we've organized our ministries around five purposes: Worship, Membership, Discipleship, Ministry, and Outreach. To familiarize our entire membership with those purposes and provide opportunities for each person to "plug in" to all of these core areas of ministry at Shiloh, we offer the **Pathway to Spiritual Formation.**

Every month, three classes on these purposes provide new and current members with tools and knowledge to know Christ, grow in Christ, connect with others, and serve others. The classes are free and meet on Sunday and Saturday. See below for the times for each class.

We invite you to take the next step in your walk with Christ and become a fully devoted follower of Jesus and a fully participating member of Shiloh as you complete all available classes. Because they build on one another, the classes must be taken in order.

Membership: Shiloh 101 (2nd Sundays at 9:45 AM).

Shiloh 101 is designed to help members discover more about our church (our history, vision, core values, priorities, ministries, and our staff) and how you can be part of what God is doing here. The opportunity to become a fully participating member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church is just one great reason to attend. This is the first step in pursuing (if you are visiting), beginning (if you have newly joined) or continuing (if you are already a member) your membership here in the Shiloh Church family. Shiloh 101 is more than a class—it is a time of fellowship with Pastor Undra Parker and First Lady Mildred Parker and with many of the leaders of Shiloh.

Maturity: Shiloh 201 (3rd Sundays at 9:45 AM)

In the Maturity Class, we'll explore some helpful habits for Bible study, prayer, and fellowship. You'll also learn how to become involved in maturity ministries at Shiloh, like Sunday School, Bible studies, the prayer ministry, and more. Shiloh 101 must be completed before attending Shiloh 201.

Ministry: Shiloh 301 (4th Saturdays at 10:00 AM)

In the Ministry Class, you'll learn about your personal S.H.A.P.E. for ministry-the talents, gifts, and abilities God gave you and how you can use them in a practical way. You'll also get an overview of various ministry opportunities at our church and see ways to "plug in" to make a difference. Shiloh 101 and Shiloh 201 must be completed before attending Shiloh 301.

Parish Family Care Groups

In his role as Senior Pastor, Pastor Undra Parker is called to shepherd (care for) the families of Shiloh. With over 500 families in Shiloh, it is difficult for the Pastor to account for, communicate with, and care for every family by himself. The Parish Family Care Ministry is the way the Senior Pastor accounts for, communicate with, and cares for every Shiloh Family. He is connected and remains connected to each family of our church through the Parish Care Ministry. This connection is strengthened, nurtured, and maintained through the services of the Diaconate Ministry.

The Shiloh Parish Family Care Ministry is made up of fourteen "Parish Family Care Groups. Each Shiloh household is assigned to a Family Care Group. The assignment is determined alphabetically—by the first letter in the member's last name, for example—"Parker" would be in the "NOP" Family Care Group.

Shiloh's Parish Family Care Ministry is led by the Director for Parish Family Care and is staffed by family care ministers who are ordained deacons and Deaconesses. Your Family Care Minister should be the first individual that you contact during a time of crisis in your family, such as an illness or death or an emergency need for food, clothing, or shelter. They will pray with you, provide spiritual directions and walk with you to Shiloh's Care Center. If your situation requires the attention of the Senior Pastor, your Care Minister will contact and inform him.

Family Care Ministers—Deacons and Deaconesses are trained lay volunteers, not professional counselors or therapists, pastors, or physicians. They are not authorized to give legal, medical, financial, or any other advice, but Bible-based encouragement. Family Care Ministers are Christians who care in the name of Christ. They provide care by listening, supporting, encouraging, praying, being dependable and trustworthy, and maintaining confidentiality in their caregiving.

Shown below is each of Shiloh's Care Ministers. Please take note of who your Care Minister is and if you haven't already established contact with him/her, please feel free to find them during any of our weekly services. If you don't remember who your Family Care Minister is, call the church office at 907.276.6673. The office will ask your Care Minister to contact you.
