A Singles Ministry ensures that single adults are not overlooked, but embraced as vital members of the church family. It fosters connection, combats isolation, and builds meaningful intergenerational relationships.

Single adults bring diverse gifts, availability, and perspectives. A ministry designed for them can empower leadership, outreach, and creative service—mobilizing them as mentors, ministry leaders, and community builders.

We also recognize the unique challenges singles may face—loneliness, societal pressure, grief, or life transitions. A dedicated ministry offers pastoral care, peer support, and practical resources for navigating life with faith, dignity, and joy.

Whether someone remains single or is preparing for marriage, their journey matters. A Singles Ministry affirms that every season of life is sacred, and every person is seen, valued, and deeply loved by God.

We need single adults who feel called to explore the possibilities of building this ministry to step forward and express their interest.

We need potential leaders—those willing to lead or be trained to lead—to raise their hands and say, “I’m ready.”
