Dr. Kim Patterson is the Lead Pastor of Kingdom Life Church-Anchorage, a multicultural community of vibrant worshippers seeking to take Kingdom (Gospel) influence into Anchorage and into all the world.

He and his wife, Mary, have been married for 38 years and have served in both faith and marketplace ministries.

Dr. Patterson is a lifelong Alaskan and enjoys the growing diversity of our state.

As an advocate for education, he has earned degrees in Social Work, Theology, and Leadership.

With a passion for Social Justice, he founded Connections Alaska, Inc in 2013 as an educational resource for re-entry and at-risk young adult men.

Dr. Patterson served 13 years at the University of Alaska Anchorage as an Educational Advisor, Instructor, and the Director of two U.S. Department of Education grant programs (Trio Programs) designed to help first-generation and low-income students access, enter, and complete postsecondary education.

Dr. Patterson is the author of two books (Swift Justice, 2012, and Becoming Visible, 2018) that encourage faith-based leaders and nonprofit professionals to act as agents of change in solving societal problems.

As a community activist, he encourages team-work within the Body of Christ and assists in leading change efforts through networking, authorship, and speaking.

The Pattersons continue to travel and present to faith and secular groups through their ministry KMAR Productions, LLC.




