⁶ Therefore let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death,^{1a} and of faith in God, ² instruction about cleansing rites,^{1b} the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. ³ And God permitting, we will do so.

⁴ It is impossible for those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, who have shared in the Holy Spirit, ⁵ who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the coming age ⁶ and who have fallen^{1a} away, to be brought back to repentance. To their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace. ⁷ Land that drinks in the rain often falling on it and that produces a crop useful to those for whom it is farmed receives the blessing of God. ⁸ But land that produces thorns and thistles is worthless and is in danger of being cursed. 



Anchorage, Alaska — January 19, 2026 — In honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.’s enduring legacy, Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church invites the Anchorage community to participate in its **annual Day of Service on Monday, January 19, 2026, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM** at the Shiloh gymnasium.

This year’s theme, “**A Day On, Not a Day Off**,” echoes Dr. King’s call to action: “*Life’s most persistent and urgent question is, ‘What are you doing for others?’*” Shiloh continues its commitment to building the **Beloved Community** through acts of compassion and civic engagement.

The church will host its **Annual Paper Products & Coffee Drive**, collecting **paper towels, toilet paper, and coffee** for **Beans Café, Brother Francis Shelter, and the Anchorage Rescue Mission**—organizations serving men, women, and children experiencing homelessness.


