Anchorage, Alaska — January 19, 2026 — In honor of **Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.**'s enduring legacy, Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church invites the Anchorage community to participate in its **annual Day of Service on Monday, January 19, 2026, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM** at the Shiloh gymnasium.

This year's theme, "**A Day On, Not a Day Off**," echoes Dr. King's call to action: "***Life's most persistent and urgent question is, 'What are you doing for others?'***" Shiloh continues its commitment to building the **Be-loved Community** through acts of compassion and civic engagement.

The church will host its **Annual Paper Products & Coffee Drive**, collecting **paper towels, toilet paper, and coffee** for **Beans Café, Brother Francis Shelter, and the Anchorage Rescue Mission**—organizations serving men, women, and children experiencing homelessness.

"We encourage families, friends, coworkers, and neighbors to join us," said Reverend Mildred Parker. "Bring your children and teach them the power of service and the legacy of Dr. King. Together, we can make a difference."

All donations can be dropped off at the Shiloh gym on the day of the event. Volunteers will be on hand to assist and share information about the shelters and ways to stay involved throughout the year.

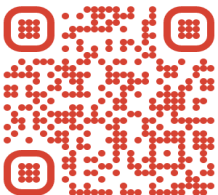
