If you've been thinking about it, praying about it, or waiting for the right moment — this is it. Step forward. Claim your place. Let's grow together in Kenai July 30-August 1.

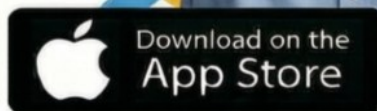

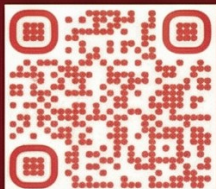
