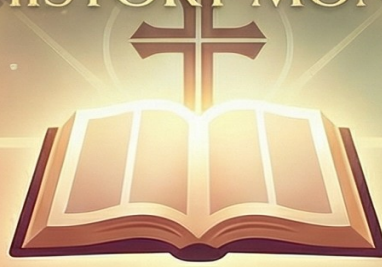

and offers welcome in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.”***

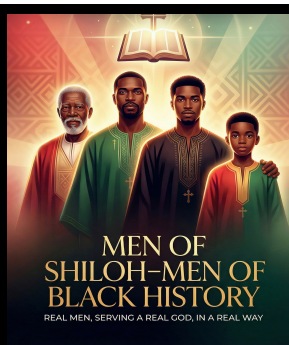


