Prayer — “Lord, Make Us One”

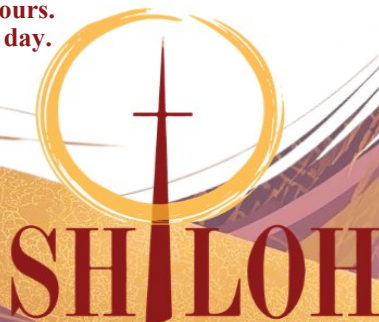
Gracious God,
