The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! <sup>30</sup>This is He of whom I said, ‘After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.’ <sup>31</sup>I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water.”
