When you arrive, you'll be connected with a team leader who will guide your group as we canvass assigned streets throughout our neighborhood.

Why We Walk These Streets

Shiloh did not arrive in Fairview by accident. When the city of Anchorage exercised eminent domain and forced Shiloh to relocate, we chose this neighborhood — then known as the **“Red Light District.”** It was a place marked by bars, strip clubs, brothels, a homeless tent city, homes with no utilities, and mud flats with no drainage.

But God gave Pastor Alonzo Patterson a vision: Purchase this property and build . . . And Shiloh will be a bright, steady light on this corner — serving, loving, and inviting our neighbors to “Come and See.”

For 53 of our 74 years, we have lived, worshiped, served, and loved right here in Fairview. And on May 16, we return to these streets to reissue the very first invitation we extended decades ago:

Neighbor — We Love You. Christ loves you. Come celebrate with us. COME AND SEE!

As we walk, we carry our history, our testimony, and our commitment to this community. And we extend a heartfelt invitation to join us on Sunday, May 24 as we celebrate 74 years in Anchorage and 53 years in this neighborhood we proudly call home.

Let's walk with joy. Let's walk with purpose — as we honor our history and embrace our mission.

Let's walk with love. Shiloh — let's go reach our neighbors.

You Don't Have to Walk Through Grief Alone

Grief touches every life. It comes through the death of loved ones, but also through the losses that shape our journey—health changes, divorce, broken relationships, job transitions, aging, empty nest, relocation, loss of identity, and seasons of unexpected change. Shiloh's Grief Ministry exists to walk with individuals and families through these valleys with compassion, biblical encouragement, and the healing presence of Christ.

Why a Grief Ministry Matters Today

1. Because grief is everywhere

People are carrying silent burdens—unspoken pain, unresolved sorrow, and life transitions that leave them feeling overwhelmed or alone. Today's world moves fast, but grief moves slowly. The church must create space for healing.

2. Because the church is called to care

Scripture commands us to “bear one another's burdens” and to comfort others with the comfort we have received from God. A Grief Ministry is not optional—it is a biblical responsibility and a pastoral necessity.

3. Because grief is more than death

Modern ministry must address the full spectrum of loss:

Loss of a spouse, child, parent, or friend • Loss of health or physical ability • Loss of employment or financial stability • Loss through divorce or separation • Loss of home or relocation • Loss of identity, purpose, or community • Loss connected to aging, caregiving, or life transitions

A healthy church recognizes these realities and responds with compassion, structure, and spiritual support.

4. Because healing requires community. People heal best when they are:

Seen ♥ Heard ♥ Supported ♥ Prayed for ♥ Surrounded by a loving church family

A Grief Ministry provides a safe, confidential, Christ-centered environment where healing can begin.

A Call to Serve: We Are Recruiting Compassionate, Spirit-Led Volunteers

Shiloh is seeking qualified, caring individuals who feel called to serve in this ministry of comfort and healing.

Ideal Ministry Team Members Are:

Spiritually mature and emotionally grounded, Good listeners with compassionate hearts. Able to maintain confidentiality. Comfortable praying with and for others. Willing to receive training. Sensitive to diverse experiences of loss. Gifted in encouragement, mercy, or pastoral care.

Training Will Be Provided

Volunteers will receive training in: Understanding the grief process. Supporting different types of loss. Trauma informed ministry. Active listening and compassionate presence. Prayer and spiritual care. Boundaries and confidentiality. When and how to refer individuals for additional support.

This ministry will operate as a team, with ongoing development, prayer support, and pastoral oversight.

Why Serve in the Grief Ministry?

Because people need: Someone to sit with them. Someone to pray with them. Someone to remind them that God has not forgotten them—the church has not forgotten them. And because God uses ordinary people to bring extraordinary comfort. *“The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.” — Psalm 34:18*
